SELF CREATED ARTWORK

Check! you have saved in pdf format If your artwork is supplied from an external designer, please ask that it is supplied in high resolution .pdf format, output is set to CMYK newsprint and contains no spot colours or RGB images. Total Inkweight should not exceed 240%. To create correct size either check the module size in AdCompose or contact our Help Desk.

If you create your own artwork in another program please save in a high resolution .pdf format. Many external programs have export artwork settings you can manipulate to suit Newsprint, Please consult your programs Help or Support guides on how to do this. To create correct size either check the module size in AdCompose or contact our Help Desk.

Do not upload your promo as a .jpg or .png file.

Doing so will cause errors or your text will print poorly in your advert.

If you have artwork you are unsure if it is suitable please contact the AdCompose Help Desk for advice.


